AN ACT

To incorporate the Worcester Mozart Choral Union.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. Alexander C. Munroe, Seth Richards,
2 Samuel E. Staples, Lyman H. Goodnow, their asso-
3 ciates and successors, are hereby made a corporation
4 by the name of the Worcester Choral Union in the
5 city of Worcester, for the purpose of the study and
6 practice of oratorio and other music; with all the
7 powers and privileges, and subject to all the duties,
8 liabilities and restrictions set forth in the general laws
9 which now are or may hereafter be in force applicable
10 to such corporations.

1 SECT. 2. Said corporation may hold real and per-
2 sonal estate to an amount not exceeding fifty thousand
3 dollars.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
