AN ACT

To incorporate the Hoosac Savings Bank of North Adams.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. Benjamin F. Robinson, Sylvander John-
2 son, Edwin R. Tinker, William S. Blackinton and
3 Edwin Thayer, their associates and successors, are
4 hereby made a corporation by the name of the Hoosac
5 Savings Bank, to be located in North Adams; with all
6 the powers and privileges, and subject to all the
7 duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in all gen-
8 eral laws which now are or hereafter may be in force
9 in this Commonwealth, relating to institutious for
10 savings.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
