AN ACT

Authorizing the Middlesex North Agricultural Society
to take Land.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The president, secretary and treasurer
2 of the Middlesex North Agricultural Society may, for
3 and on behalf of said society, lease, purchase or other-
4 wise take a parcel or parcels of land, not exceeding
5 thirty acres in extent, adjoining the present grounds
6 of said society in the city of Lowell for the purposes
7 named in their act of incorporation.

1 SECT. 2. The said officers shall, within sixty days
2 after such taking, file for record in the northern dis-
3 trict of the registry of deeds for said county, a descrip-
4 tion of the land so taken, and the title of the same

5 shall thereupon vest in said society: *provided, how-*
6 *ever*, that the title to any lot or lots of land taken
7 shall revert in the owner or owners, or their heirs or
8 assigns, whenever said society shall cease to occupy
9 said land for the purposes aforesaid.

1 SECT. 3. All damages occasioned by the taking of
2 land under this act may be determined and recovered
3 in the same manner as is now provided by law in case
4 of lands taken for highways.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
