AN ACT

To legalize the acts and doings of the Annual Town Meeting of the Town of Southwick.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The acts and doings of the town meeting
2 held in the town of Southwick, on the third day of
3 April, eighteen hundred and seventy-one, are hereby
4 confirmed and made valid to the same extent as they
5 would have been valid had an article been inserted in
6 the warrant calling said meeting, to choose a modera-
7 tor, the same having been omitted by mistake.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
