AN ACT

Relating to the Punishment of Larceny.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. Whoever is convicted of simple larceny
2 committed in the city of Boston, of property whose
3 value does not exceed one hundred dollars, may, in
4 the discretion of the court, be committed to the house
5 of industry in said city for a term not exceeding one
6 year.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
