RESOLVE

In favor of Isadora F. Lincoln.

Resolved, That on and after the first day of January, eighteen hundred and eighty-one, Isadora F. Lincoln, widow of Benjamin C. Lincoln, a member of Company "G," thirty-ninth regiment, Massachusetts volunteers, and afterwards captain of second United States colored troops, shall be entitled to receive the same amount of State aid she would have been entitled to, had her husband, when killed in action, been serving in the regiment in which he originally enlisted.
