AN ACT

Making New Year's Day a Legal Holiday.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECTION 1. The first day of January of each year
2 is hereby made a legal holiday, to all intents and
3 purposes, in the same manner as Thanksgiving, Fast,
4 and Christmas days, the twenty-second day of Feb-
5 ruary and the fourth day of July are now by law
6 made public holidays.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
