RESOLVE

Regarding Sewage of the City of Worcester.

Resolved, That the State Board of Health, Lunacy, and Charity is hereby authorized and directed to examine and consider the question of the disposition of the sewage of the city of Worcester, especially with a view to prevent the pollution of the Blackstone River and its tributaries, and report its conclusions in print to the next Legislature, with recommendations as to a definite plan for the prevention of such pollution. For this purpose, the board may employ such assistants and incur such other expenses as shall be approved by the Governor and Council.
