RESOLVE

In favor of the Trustees of the Soldiers' Home in
Massachusetts.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth, to the Trustees of the
3 Soldiers' Home in Massachusetts, the sum of twenty
4 thousand dollars, the same to be used towards the main-
5 tenance of a home for deserving soldiers and sailors.
