AN ACT

To provide for the Appointment of an Assistant Clerk of the Police Court of Lowell.

[House No. 33 in a new draft.]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows.

1 SECTION 1. The clerk of the police court of
2 Lowell may appoint an assistant clerk, who shall
3 be subject to all the provisions of law applicable
4 to assistant clerks of district courts and perform
5 all duties prescribed therefor.

1 SECT. 2. Said assistant clerk shall receive an
2 annual salary of one thousand dollars, to be paid
3 out of the treasury of the Commonwealth.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
