### RESOLVE

In favor of George White.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to George White, judge  
3 of probate and insolvency for the county of Norfolk, the  
4 sum of eight hundred and thirty-seven dollars and thirty-  
5 six cents, as full compensation for services and expenses  
6 in discharging by designation the duties of judge of pro-  
7 bate and insolvency of Essex County between the dates  
8 of July eleventh and October seventh, eighteen hundred  
9 and eighty-eight.
