AN ACT

To amend Chapter One Hundred and Seventy-one of the Acts of the Year Eighteen Hundred and Eighty-eight, entitled an Act to supply the Centre Village of Leicester with Water.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter one hun-
2 dred and seventy-one of the acts of eighteen
3 hundred and eighty-eight, entitled an act to
4 supply the centre village of Leicester with water,
5 is hereby amended by striking out after the word
6 "meter" the words, "or the waters of any
7 springs or other water sources, on the water-
8 shed of said brooks above the one mile limit
9 above defined," and inserting in lieu thereof the
10 words, "and the waters of any springs, wells or

11 other ground water sources on the water-shed of
12 said Kettle brook in the town of Paxton.”

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
