Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-nine.

AN ACT

To revive the Powers and extend the Time for constructing the Railroad of the New York and Boston Inland Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The time within which to complete
2 the construction of the railroad of the New York
3 and Boston inland railroad company is hereby
4 extended until the first day of June in the year
5 one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, and
6 all the rights, powers, privileges and franchises
7 originally possessed or enjoyed by said company
8 are to continue and be enjoyed by it in the same
9 manner and with the same effect as if its railroad

10 had been constructed within the time prescribed
11 by law: *provided*, that the sum of one hundred
12 thousand dollars is actually expended by said
13 company in the construction of its railroad before
14 the first day of July, A.D., eighteen hundred and
15 ninety.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
