RESOLVE

Providing for the Completion and Furnishing of the Hospital Accommodations for Men, and Moving the Barn at the State Almshouse at Tewksbury.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding thir-
3 teen thousand five hundred dollars, the same to be
4 expended under the direction of the trustees and super-
5 intendent of the State almshouse at Tewksbury, for the
6 following purposes : for the completion and furnishing of
7 the " additional hospital accommodations for men," a sum
8 not exceeding eight thousand five hundred dollars ; for
9 the removal and repair of the barn a sum not exceeding
10 five thousand dollars.
