AN ACT

To amend An Act to incorporate the Trustees of
Tufts College.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The trustees of Tufts College
2 may establish and maintain a preparatory school,
3 and for this purpose said corporation shall be
4 capable of taking and holding in fee, or any less
5 estate, by gift, grant, bequest, devise, or other-
6 wise, any lands, tenements, or other estate, real
7 or personal; *provided*, that the clear annual in-
8 come of the same shall not exceed twenty thou-
9 sand dollars; and said corporation may act as
10 trustee in accepting, holding and managing
11 estates for said school or incident thereto, and in
12 executing such trusts.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
