AN ACT

To repeal Chapter One Hundred and Eighty of the Acts of the Year Eighteen Hundred and Seventy-five and Chapter Forty-nine of the Acts of the Year Eighteen Hundred and Seventy-six prohibiting the seining of Fish in the Ponds on the Island of Nantucket.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and eighty
2 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
3 seventy-five, and chapter forty-nine of the acts of
4 the year eighteen hundred and seventy-six, pro-
5 hibiting the seining of fish in the ponds on the
6 island of Nantucket, are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
