AN ACT

Concerning the Association for the Protection of
Destitute Roman Catholic Children in Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The corporation established under chapter
2 thirty-two of the General Statutes of the Com-
3 monwealth of Massachusetts, by the name of
4 the Association for the Protection of Destitute
5 Roman Catholic Children in Boston, may be
6 appointed guardian of any minor child in its
7 care, with the same powers and duties as are
8 prescribed for guardians of minor children by
9 chapter one hundred thirty-nine of the Public
10 Statutes.
