Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to purchase certain flats belonging to the Commonwealth in South Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston may, within
2 sixty days of the passage of this act, pass an
3 order to purchase of the Commonwealth on the
4 terms hereinafter prescribed, a parcel of land
5 situated in that part of said Boston called South
6 Boston, bounded and described as follows:—
7 Beginning at the intersection of Cypher street, so
8 called, and the easterly line of C street as laid

9 out sixty feet wide by the board of harbor and
10 land commissioners ; thence running northerly,
11 on said easterly line of C street, as laid out by
12 said board, eleven hundred feet ; thence easterly,
13 at right angles to said easterly line of C street, to
14 the westerly line of D street as laid out by said
15 board ; thence southerly, on said westerly line of
16 D street, eleven hundred feet to the northerly
17 line of Cypher street aforesaid ; thence westerly,
18 in said northely line of Cypher street, to the
19 point of beginning ; containing twelve acres, and
20 one half of an acre, more or less.

1 SECT. 2. On the passage of said order, the
2 board of harbor and land commissioners shall, in
3 behalf of the Commonwealth, convey said parcel
4 of land to said city upon the condition that said
5 parcel of land shall never be built upon ; and said
6 city, in payment therefor, shall each year, on or
7 before the first day of June, pay to the treasurer
8 of the Commonwealth the sum of twenty thousand
9 dollars, until it shall have made eight such pay-
10 ments in all.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
