AN ACT

Relating to Crossings at Grade by Railroads for
Private Use.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. When the consent of the board
2 of railroad commissioners is required for a cross-
3 ing of a way or travelled place by a railroad for
4 private use said board may limit the number of
5 tracks, and may impose such other conditions in
6 relation to the use of the crossing as may be
7 deemed expedient, and may from time to time
8 modify such limitations and conditions as circum-
9 stances may require.
