RESOLVE

For Completing the Preparation and Publication of the
Province Laws.

1 *Resolved*, That the governor, with the consent of the
2 council, is authorized to appoint for a term not exceeding
3 three years from the first day of February in the present
4 year three suitable persons, learned in the law and his-
5 tory of Massachusetts, to complete the preparation and
6 publication of the Acts and Resolves of the Province of
7 Massachusetts Bay, of whom one shall edit said work
8 and receive therefor, for a period not exceeding said
9 term, such annual compensation as has been fixed by the
10 governor and council for the commissioner appointed
11 under chapter sixty-five of the resolves of the year eigh-
12 teen hundred and eighty-nine; and the other two shall
13 serve without compensation except such reimbursement
14 or allowance for travelling and other expenses as the
15 governor and council shall approve. Said commissioners
16 shall be provided with an office in some suitable place in
17 the city of Boston and shall in writing make a report of
18 their doings to the legislature in January of each year.
