### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Newton to divide Ward Four into Voting Precincts, so that the Villages of Auburndale and Newton Lower Falls shall each be a Precinct.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The mayor and aldermen of the  
2 city of Newton may divide the fourth ward of  
3 said city into two precincts, so that the village of  
4 Auburndale and the territory contiguous thereto  
5 shall constitute one such precinct, and the village  
6 of Newton Lower Falls and the territory conti-  
7 guous thereto shall constitute the other precinct.  
8 The boundaries of such precincts shall as far as  
9 possible be the centre lines of known streets or  
10 ways.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
