AN ACT

To Further Regulate the Observance of the Lord's Day.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section two of chapter three hundred and ninety-one
- 2 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-
- 3 seven is hereby amended by striking out the word
- 4 "retail" before the words "sale and delivery of milk."
