AN ACT

To Extend the Penalty Imposed upon Railroad Corporations
for Failure to Comply with Law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Any railroad corporation which fails to
2 comply with the provisions of chapter three hundred and
3 eighty-nine of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
4 and ninety-two shall forfeit fifty dollars for each refusal
5 to comply with said provisions.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect July first, eighteen
2 hundred and ninety-three.
