[Bill accompanying the petition of the town of Lenox for legislation conferring additional powers upon said town in relation to its system of sewage disposal.]

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-three.

AN ACT

Conferring Additional Powers upon the Town of Lenox in relation to its System of Sewage Disposal.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The power and authority con-
2 ferred upon the town of Lenox by chapter two
3 hundred and seventy-one of the acts of the year
4 eighteen hundred and eighty-six shall continue
5 in full force and effect. And said town is hereby
6 granted such additional power and authority as
7 may be necessary to enable it to acquire any

8 lands, rights of way or easements, in accordance
9 with the provisions of said former act, which may
10 be required for the erection, maintenance and use
11 of a pumping station and all connecting force
12 mains, pipes and sewers for the disposal of
13 sewage in said town. And said town is also
14 hereby authorized to raise and appropriate, in
15 such manner as it shall determine, such sums of
16 money as shall be necessary to carry into effect
17 the provisions of this act.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
