RESOLVE

Providing for Certain Equipment, Buildings, Insurance and Repairs at the Massachusetts Agricultural College.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth, a sum not exceeding
3 thirty-nine thousand five hundred dollars, to be expended
4 under the direction of the trustees of the Massachusetts
5 agricultural college for the following purposes: one
6 thousand two hundred dollars for additional accommoda-
7 tions in the chemical department; one thousand eight
8 hundred dollars to provide for disposal of sewage; one
9 thousand five hundred dollars to renew the insurance on
10 eighteen buildings and the furniture, apparatus, col-
11 lections, tools, hay, grain and animals contained therein;
12 eight thousand five hundred dollars for building and
13 equipping a dairy school; one thousand five hundred
14 dollars for moving, repairing and refitting the farm
15 house; twenty-five thousand dollars for a storage barn,
16 cow barn, sheep and hog barn, horse barn, implement
17 storage barn and other necessary buildings.
