AN ACT

To change the Sessions of the First District Court of Eastern Middlesex.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sessions of the first district court of
2 eastern Middlesex, now held on Wednesday and Thurs-
3 day of each week at Wakefield, shall hereafter be held
4 at Malden; and all processes issued or returnable and
5 now pending at said Wakefield shall be heard and deter-
6 mined at said Malden.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on July first, A.D.
2 eighteen hundred and ninety-three.
