### AN ACT

Relative to the Granting of First Class Licenses to  
Innholders.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 No license of the first class, as designated in  
2 section ten of chapter one hundred of the Public  
3 Statutes, for the sale of intoxicating liquors shall  
4 be granted to any innholder after the thirtieth day  
5 of April, eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, un-  
6 less the following conditions exist: —

7 *First.* The applicant for said license shall  
8 hold a victualler's license.

9 *Second.* The said applicant shall be the owner  
10 or lessee of building or buildings adjoining con-  
11 taining twenty-five or more rooms suitably fur-  
12 nished for the accommodation of lodgers.

13 *Third.* Said rooms shall not contain less than  
14 one hundred feet of floor area.
