AN ACT

To Establish the Salary of the Clerk of the District Court of Southern Berkshire.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the clerk of the  
2 district court of Southern Berkshire shall be  
3 seven hundred dollars a year, to be so allowed from  
4 the first day of January, in the year eighteen  
5 hundred and ninety-seven.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
