RESOLVE

To provide for Celebrating the Centennial Anniversary of
the Launching of the Frigate Constitution.

1 *Resolved*, That his excellency the governor, the presi-
2 dent of the senate, the speaker of the house, and such
3 other members as the senate and house of representatives
4 may join, shall constitute a committee with authority to
5 arrange for a suitable celebration of the centennial anni-
6 versary of the launching of the frigate Constitution,
7 provided the presence of said frigate in Boston harbor
8 can be secured at that time.

9 For the expenses incident to the celebration hereby
10 authorized, a sum not exceeding twenty thousand dollars
11 may be expended under the direction of said committee.
