AN ACT

To authorize the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Boston to appoint Inspectors of Excavations made by Corporations in the Streets of said City.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The superintendent of streets of  
2 the city of Boston may appoint such number of  
3 competent inspectors as may be necessary to su-  
4 pervise excavations made in the streets of said  
5 city by corporations obtaining permits therefor,  
6 and the compensation of such inspectors shall be  
7 paid by the several corporations obtaining such per-  
8 mits. It shall be the duty of said inspectors to

9 supervise such excavations, the refilling of the  
10 same and the resurfacing of the street, and to  
11 cause all of said work to be done in such manner  
12 as to restore the streets to as good a condition as  
13 they were in before the making therein of such  
14 excavations.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
