AN ACT

Relative to Savings and Loan Associations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The following associations shall be
2 subject to the provisions of sections two to fifteen,
3 inclusive, of chapter five hundred and ninety of
4 the acts of nineteen hundred and eight:—At
5 tleborough Savings and Loan Association of Attle-
6 borough, Plainville Savings and Loan Association
7 of North Attleborough and the Norton Savings and
8 Loan Association of Norton.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
