

SENATE No. 92

To accompany the petition of John F. Fitzgerald, mayor of the city of Boston, that said city be authorized to assess betterments for the construction of the Washington Street boulevard. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twelve.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to assess Betterments for the Construction of the Washington Street Boulevard in West Roxbury from Lagrange Street to the Dedham Line.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of street commissioners
2 of the city of Boston is hereby authorized to assess
3 betterments within two years from the date of the
4 passage of this act for the public improvement au-
5 thorized by chapter five hundred and seventy-four
6 of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and seven,
7 being entitled "An act to provide for the laying
8 out and construction as a state highway of Wash-
9 ington street in the West Roxbury district of the

10 city of Boston", in accordance with the provisions
11 of chapter three hundred and ninety-three of the
12 acts of the year nineteen hundred and six.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this act "the
2 assessable cost of the improvement" shall mean
3 the cost to the city of Boston of said improvement
4 including such sum or sums as said city has paid or
5 may be bound to pay on account of the provisions
6 of said chapter five hundred and seventy-four of the
7 acts of nineteen hundred and seven, to the common-
8 wealth.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
