## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### RESOLVE

To provide for the Appointment of a Commission to Investigate and Report as to the Conditions now Existing between Cottage Owners at Salisbury Beach and the Salisbury Beach Associates and the Liabilities of such Owners to said Associates.

1 *Resolved*, That the governor, with the advice and con-  
2 sent of the council, shall appoint a commission consist-  
3 ing of five persons, citizens of the commonwealth who  
4 shall investigate and report within ninety days from their  
5 appointment as to the conditions now existing at Salis-  
6 bury beach between cottage owners and the Salisbury  
7 Beach Associates and as to the legal liabilities of such  
8 cottage owners to said associates. The report shall be  
9 made to the general court, if it is then in session, but if  
10 it is not in session the report shall be made to the gov-

11 error and shall be open to inspection by any person in-  
12 terested. The commission shall have power to administer  
13 oaths, to summon persons and to require the production  
14 of papers, and may incur such reasonable and necessary  
15 expenses, and shall receive such compensation, as may  
16 be approved by the governor and council.
