

SENATE No. 138

To accompany the petition of W. F. Houston that the General Charitable Society of Newburyport be authorized to hold additional real and personal estate. Mercantile Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twelve.

AN ACT

To authorize the Trustees of the General Charitable Society of Newburyport to hold Additional Real and Personal Estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The trustees of the General Charita-
2 ble Society of Newburyport are hereby authorized
3 to hold real and personal estate to an amount, in-
4 cluding that now held by said corporation, not ex-
5 ceeding seventy-five thousand dollars, which prop-
6 erty and the income derived therefrom shall be
7 devoted to the purposes set forth in the charter of
8 the corporation.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
