To accompany the petition of Herbert E. Dodge and another, water commissioners of the town of Saugus, for legislation relative to surplus of income in the hands of said commissioners. Towns.

AN ACT

Relative to the Water Commissioners of the Town of
Saugus.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section four of chapter ninety-one of the
2 acts of nineteen hundred and eleven is hereby amended
3 by inserting in line seven, after the word "act", the
4 words:— whenever the commissioners shall have on
5 hand money in excess of the amount required during the
6 current year for payment of interest or principal of
7 any debts incurred under the authority of this act, they
8 may pay the same or any part thereof to the town treas-
9 urer and he shall use the same in the payment of prin-
10 cipal or interest on any bonds, notes or scrip of the
11 town issued prior to the passage of this act for the pur-
12 pose of supplying the town with water.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
