AN ACT

Relative to the Salaries of the Justice, Clerk and Assistant Clerk of the Municipal Court of the Charlestown District of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter four hundred and fifty-three of the
2 acts of the year nineteen hundred and four is hereby amended
3 by inserting after the word "Boston", in line two, the
4 words:— and the municipal court of the Charlestown dis-
5 trict, — and by striking out, in lines five and six, of Class F
6 of said section, the words "the municipal court of the
7 Charlestown district"; and section two of chapter four
8 hundred and fifty-three of the acts of nineteen hundred and
9 four is hereby amended by adding:—The salaries of the
10 justice and clerk of the municipal court of the Charlestown
11 district, and of an assistant clerk of said municipal court
12 to be appointed under the provisions of section eleven of
13 chapter one hundred and sixty of the Revised Laws, shall
14 be:—Justice, three thousand dollars; clerk, eighteen
15 hundred dollars; assistant clerk, twelve hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
