

SENATE No. 505

To accompany the petition of Claude L. Allen that the city of Melrose be authorized to set apart certain lands for an enclosed athletic field. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twelve.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Melrose to set apart Certain Lands for an Enclosed Athletic Field.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. So much of the park lands now under the
2 jurisdiction of the park commissioners of the city of Melrose
3 as shall be designated for that purpose by the board of park
4 commissioners of the said city by a vote of two-thirds of its
5 members, shall be set apart for an enclosed athletic field,
6 under such regulations as may be prescribed by said park
7 commissioners. A plan showing the portion of land so set
8 apart shall be made and kept on file in the office of the park
9 commissioners.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the board of
2 aldermen of said city and shall take effect upon its accept-
3 ance by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting
4 thereon, with the approval of the mayor.
