

of Hingham and of The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company of Massachusetts in said town made lawful, notwithstanding, etc.

Proviso.

and all lines for the transmission of intelligence by electricity heretofore acquired or constructed by The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company of Massachusetts, upon, along, over or under the public ways and places of said town, and the poles, piers, abutments, conduits and other fixtures necessary to sustain or protect the wires of said lines, and in actual use on the effective date of this act, are hereby made lawful notwithstanding the lack of any valid locations therefor or any informality in the proceedings relative to their location and erection; provided, that the said town of Hingham by its municipal lighting board and said company shall, not later than the first day of December in the current year, file with the town clerk a map or maps showing in detail the location and nature of the said lines, structures and fixtures in said town; such map or maps to be recorded and kept with the records of original locations for poles and wires in said town.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Chap. 48* AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN LANDS AND WATERS NOW UNDER JURISDICTION OR CONTROL OF THE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF MEDFORD BE TRANSFERRED TO THE JURISDICTION AND CONTROL OF THE PARK DEPARTMENT OF SAID CITY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Certain lands and waters in city of Medford to be under control of park department of said city.

SECTION 1. The lands and waters in that part of the city of Medford within the area bounded by Forest street, Elm street, Woodland road and the Stonham line, now under the control or jurisdiction of the water and sewer department of the said city of Medford, shall hereafter be under the control and jurisdiction of the park department of the said city.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Chap. 49* AN ACT CREATING AN EMERGENCY FINANCE BOARD AND DEFINING ITS POWERS AND DUTIES.

Emergency preamble.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would defeat its purpose, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Emergency finance board, membership, terms.

SECTION 1. There shall be in the department of the state treasurer, subject to his control only to the extent of his membership therein, an emergency finance board, hereinafter called the board, consisting of the state treasurer and the director of the division of accounts, ex officio, and three citizens of the commonwealth to be appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the council,
