AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Metropolitan Parks Loan Sinking Fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of thirty-three hundred
2 and fifty dollars is hereby appropriated, to be
3 paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth
4 from the ordinary revenue, for the metropolitan
5 loan sinking fund, towards retiring the scrip
6 issued, known as series two, as provided for in
7 chapter two hundred and eighty-eight, of the
8 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-
9 four, being the estimate of the treasurer and
10 receiver-general.

(Appropriation 1896, \$3,350.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
