AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses
of the Inspectors of Gas Meters.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary rev-
4 enue, for the purposes specified, to meet expenses
5 for the year ending on the thirty-first day of
6 December, in the year eighteen hundred and
7 ninety-seven, to wit:—

8 For the salary of the inspector of gas meters,
9 two thousand dollars. [Pub. Stat., chap. 61,
10 sect. 2.]

(Appropriation 1896, \$2,000.)

11 For the salary of the assistant inspector of
12 gas meters, twelve hundred dollars. [Pub. Stat.,
13 chap. 61.]

(Appropriation 1896, \$1,200.)

14 For travelling and incidental expenses of the
15 inspector and assistant inspector of gas meters, a
16 sum not exceeding six hundred and fifty dollars.

18 1895, chap. 463.]

(Appropriation 1896, \$650.)

19 For such additional apparatus as the inspector
20 of gas meters may find necessary, a sum not
21 exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars. [Pub.
22 Stat., chap. 61; Res. 1856, chap. 74; Acts 1895,
23 chap. 463.]

(Appropriation 1896, \$250.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
