Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-seven.

AN ACT

For the Better Protection of Fish and Game.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The district police shall have the
2 same authority to enforce the laws relating to
3 inland fisheries and game, as now held and exer-
4 cised by the commissioners on inland fisheries and
5 game.

1 SECT. 2. The steamer now owned by the
2 Commonwealth, and used by the commissioners
3 on inland fisheries and game, in the enforcement
4 of the laws mentioned in section one, is hereby

5 transferred to the district police department, for
6 use under the direction of the chief of the district
7 police for enforcement of the laws of the Com-
8 monwealth.

1 SECT. 3. Section two of chapter three hun-
2 dred and eighty-nine of the acts of the year
3 eighteen hundred and eighty-eight is hereby
4 repealed.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
