In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-seven.

AN ACT

To protect the Constitutional Right of Petition from being Dependent on Statute Law requiring the Expenditure of Money by a Petitioner.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter twenty-four of the acts
2 of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five, as
3 amended by chapter three hundred and two of
4 the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety
5 is hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
