### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Expenses in connection with the Topographical Survey and Map of Massachusetts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of  
'3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the purposes specified, to meet the expenses  
5 for the year ending on the thirty-first day of  
6 December, in the year eighteen hundred and  
7 ninety-seven, to wit:—

8 For the determination of town boundary lines,  
9 a sum not exceeding fourteen thousand dollars.  
10 [Res. 1885, chap. 49.]

(Appropriation 1896, \$11,000.)

11 For marking town boundary lines, a sum not  
12 exceeding five hundred dollars. [Acts 1888,  
13 chap. 336.]

(Appropriation 1896, \$500.)

14 For selling and distributing maps, a sum not  
15 exceeding one thousand dollars. [Res. 1890,  
16 chap. 57.]

(Appropriation 1896, \$1,000.)

17 For supplementing topographical maps and  
18 leveling, a sum not exceeding five hundred dol-  
19 lars. [Res. 1893, chap. 11.]

(Appropriation 1896, \$500.)

20 For instruments and repairs to same, a sum not  
21 exceeding one hundred dollars. [Res. 1893,  
22 chap. 11.]

(Appropriation 1896, \$100.)

23 For duplicating atlases of town boundary plans,  
24 a sum not exceeding two thousand dollars. [Res.  
25 1895, chap. 41.]

(Appropriation 1896, \$2,000.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
