RESOLVE

In favor of Lavinia A. Barbour.

- 1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to Lavinia A. Barbour,
3 widow of James K. Barbour, who was injured while
4 defending property at the Cooper Street riot, an annuity
5 of three hundred and fifty dollars, to be paid to said
6 widow during the term of her natural life, payable in
7 equal quarterly instalments.
- 8 Chapter eight of the resolves of the year eighteen hun-
9 dred and ninety-five is hereby repealed.
