In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-seven.

AN ACT

To require the West End Street Railway Company
to Furnish Power for Watering the Streets.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The West End Street Railway
2 Company on request of the mayor of the city of
3 Boston shall, during such months of each year as
4 said mayor may from time to time specify, furnish
5 electric power and use of tracks for running
6 watering cars through any streets in which the
7 tracks of said company are laid. The use of
8 power and tracks shall be furnished for said pur-
9 pose without compensation, as a return, in part,
10 for the privilege enjoyed by said company of
11 running its cars through said streets.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
