In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-seven.

AN ACT

To amend Chapter Ninety-seven of the Acts of the Year Eighteen Hundred and Ninety-five, being "An Act relative to the erection and alteration of buildings in the city of Boston."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No building hereafter erected in the city
2 of Boston shall be occupied by more than three families,
3 or above the first story by more than two families, unless
4 it is a first or second-class building, and no second-class
5 building more than sixty-five feet in height above the
6 cellar bottom shall be erected, enlarged or altered, and
7 occupied as a lodging house, tenement house, or dwell-
8 ing house, unless the basement and first story shall be
9 constructed in the manner provided for the basement and
10 first story of first-class buildings, under section twenty-
11 three of chapter four hundred and nineteen of the acts of
12 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-two.

1 SECT. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with
2 this act are hereby repealed. This act shall take effect
3 upon its passage.
