RESOLVE

To confirm the Acts of George W. Anderson as a Justice of
the Peace.

1 *Resolved*, That all the acts of George W. Anderson of
2 Boston as a justice of the peace, between the thirty-first
3 day of July in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six
4 and the eighth day of December in the year eighteen
5 hundred and ninety-six, are hereby confirmed and made
6 valid to the same extent as though he had been during
7 that time qualified to discharge the duties of said office.
