In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-seven.

AN ACT

To authorize Towns to appropriate Money for the Payment of the Charges of Insurance Companies as Sureties on Bonds of Town Officials.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Any town may at a legal town meeting  
2 vote to raise and appropriate money to pay a proper  
3 charge of an insurance company for acting as surety on  
4 the official bond given to such town by any of its officers  
5 for the faithful discharge of their duties. The selectmen  
6 of such town may accept an insurance company as suf-  
7 ficient surety upon such bond ; but no insurance company  
8 shall be so accepted unless it is qualified to do business  
9 in this Commonwealth.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
