AN ACT

To provide that the Unappropriated Receipts from Tide-water Lands shall be paid into the Harbor Compensation Fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All receipts from the sales of public
2 lands and flats not specifically appropriated, and all
3 receipts under the provisions of section sixteen of chap-
4 ter nineteen of the Public Statutes, being for rights and
5 privileges granted in the tide-water lands of the Com-
6 monwealth, which under the provisions of section three
7 of chapter three hundred and thirteen of the acts of the
8 year eighteen hundred and sixty-four, section three of
9 chapter one hundred and twenty-two of the acts of the
10 year eighteen hundred and sixty-five, and chapter eight
11 of the resolves of the year eighteen hundred and seven-
12 ty-two, are now paid into the Troy and Greenfield
13 railroad loan sinking fund, shall on and after the first
14 day of September in the year eighteen hundred and
15 ninety-seven be paid into the harbor compensation fund

16 established under the provisions of chapter seventy-four
17 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-
18 eight.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
