### AN ACT

To provide for the Appointment of a Fourth Assistant Clerk of the Municipal Court of the City of Boston for Civil Business.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. There shall be appointed, in the manner  
2 provided by law for the appointment of assistant clerks  
3 of the municipal court of the city of Boston, a fourth  
4 assistant clerk of said court, for civil business, who shall  
5 receive from the county of Suffolk an annual salary of  
6 fifteen hundred dollars.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
